I, Mariel Mota, having been first duly sworn, depose and say that the accompanying accusatory instrument is based upon the information set forth below, which is true as I verily believe. That I am employed as a Deputy District Attorney for Multnomah County, Oregon. That in the course of my duties, I have reviewed search warrants and their resulting evidence, spoken with Portland Police Officers and read the incident report(s) that I know to have been prepared by Portland Police Bureau Detective Broughton concerning the investigation of criminal acts in Multnomah County, Oregon, committed by BENJAMIN SMITH.

That on February 19, 2022, Portland Police Bureau officers responded to an emergency call for service at the intersection of NE 55th Avenue and NE Hassalo Street in Portland, OR regarding 'multiple shots fired.' Upon arrival, a uniformed officer observed several people attempting to provide medical assistance to several other people on scene. The officer learned that multiple people had been injured by a firearm. Several people in the crowd identified an injured male as the shooter, and the officer quickly took him into custody while continuing to render medical aid. After emergency medical teams arrived on scene, multiple people were taken to the hospital for treatment. The ensuing police investigation revealed the following information, some of which was captured on video:

On February 19, 2022 between 2000 and 2100 hours, Benjamin Smith (hereinafter "Defendant") confronted a group of people engaged in an organized demonstration at Normandale Park. Defendant approached the demonstration and confronted several of its participants, yelling at them and demanding they leave the area. Participants are heard on the video telling

Defendant to leave them alone and return home. Defendant responds by demanding they "make" him leave and he approaches a participant aggressively, who pushes him back. Defendant continues to yell at participants and a few moments later, Defendant draws a handgun and fires at multiple people, striking five. The shooting ended when Defendant was shot in the hip area. After everyone who needed medical attention received it, officers established a crime scene perimeter and rapidly began their investigation.

Brandy Lynn Knightly was shot at close range in the head and died on scene. Four other people had gunshot wounds and were transported to area hospitals, suffering varying degrees of injury:

'Victim 1' was struck in the neck, paralyzed from the neck down, and is currently hospitalized in critical condition; 'Victim 2' was struck in multiple places, including the abdomen, and is currently hospitalized; 'Victim 3' was struck in multiple places and has been treated and released by an area hospital; 'Victim 4' was struck in the upper arm area, and has been treated and released by an area hospital. Defendant was also transported to the hospital where he was in critical condition, requiring surgery due to a gunshot wound to his hip. Portland Police Bureau officers have remained with Defendant at the hospital continuously since he was admitted.

That the police report(s) from this incident and other computerized criminal records identify the defendant as BENJAMIN SMITH, a White Male, 11/28/1978, with a last known address in Portland, Oregon.

That based upon the foregoing information, I have probable cause to believe that BENJAMIN SMITH has committed the crime(s) of: COUNT 1 - MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 2 - ATTEMPTED MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 3 - ATTEMPTED MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 4 - ATTEMPTED MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 5 - ATTEMPTED MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 6 - ASSAULT IN THE FIRST DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 7 - ASSAULT IN THE FIRST DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, COUNT 8 - ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE WITH A FIREARM, and COUNT 9 - ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE WITH A FIREARM. I move the Court on the within information that a warrant be issued for the apprehension of said defendant.
