STATUS CONFERENCE ORDER


The parties appeared in the above-captioned case on April 27, 2022, for a status conference. Jonathan Sarre appeared for the Defendant; Defendant was not able to appear due to physical health issues. Deputy District Attorneys Nathan Vasquez and Mariel Mota appeared for the State.

After conferring with counsel, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Pursuant to the request of defense counsel, the Court finds good cause to extend the 60 day period to commence trial under ORS 136.290. In accordance with ORS 136.295(4)(b)(C), the Court finds that defense counsel cannot reasonably be expected to try the case within 60 days owing to Defendant's physical health problems and lack of access for counsel to communicate with Defendant. The Court will extend the deadline an additional 60 days for a total of 120 days after time of arrest. The new deadline for commencement of trial is July 21, 2022. The Court will also extend the deadline to request a bail hearing 60 days to July 21, 2022.

A status conference is scheduled for May 12, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. with Judge Greenlick.
